

الْحَرْفُ الْحَرْفِيُّ

Al-Harf-al-masdariyy **حَرْفُ الْمَصْدَرِيِّ** is also called

Al mawsuul-al-Harfiyyi **المَوْصُولُ الْحَرْفِيُّ**.

It is mawsuul like **الَّذِي** and **مَا**, but these two are

Asmaa **أَسْمَاء** (nouns), but **أَنَّ** and **أَنْ** are **حُرُوفٌ**

(particles).

That is why these are called mawsuul-al-Harfiyyi

المَوْصُولُ الْحَرْفِيُّ and what follows them is called

Silatul-mawsuuli-Harfiyyi **صِلَةُ الْمَوْصُولِ الْحَرْفِيِّ**.
